Edward Dunn made a motion to approve the request, 2<sup>nd</sup> by David McDaniel, all in favor none opposed, motion carried.


David McDaniel made a motion to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Terry Wilson, all in favor, none opposed motion carried.
